Description - (Hilly, with some stairways, skywalks, and building interiors)
Rosslyn has served as a proud gateway into Arlington dating back to the colonial era, when Awbrey's Ferry took passengers across the Potomac from Georgetown. The community that developed along the shore took its name from Ross Lynn, a local farm. Metrorail arrived in the late 1970s, cementing the area as a transportation hub. Today, Rosslyn is undergoing a second boom, with bold skyscrapers, majestic vistas, cultural and recreational attractions and plenty of transit options attracting more and more residents and visitors every day.
