

1995/281. Situation of human rights in Haiti

At its 52nd plenary meeting, on 25 July 1995, the Economic and Social Council, taking note of Commission on Human Rights resolution 1995/70 of 8 March 1995,⁶¹ approved the Commission's request to the Secretary-General to appoint an independent expert to furnish assistance to the Government of Haiti in the area of human rights, to examine the development of the situation of human rights in Haiti and to monitor the fulfilment by Haiti of its obligations in this field, also approved the Commission's request to the independent expert to submit a report on the implementation of resolution 1995/70 to the General Assembly at its fiftieth session and to the Commission on Human Rights at its fifty-second session, and further approved the Commission's request to the Secretary-General to provide, at the request of the Government of Haiti, advisory services to that country in the area of human rights.
