

1996/217. Review of quadrennial reports submitted by non-governmental organizations in consultative status with the Economic and Social Council, categories I and II

At its 4th plenary meeting, on 2 May 1996, the Economic and Social Council decided that, pursuant to the provisions of paragraph 40 (b) of Council resolution 1296 (XLIV) of 23 May 1968, the consultative status of the following twelve organizations, which had failed to submit a detailed report on their activities for the period 1988-1991, as requested by the Committee in 1993,¹³⁶ be withdrawn:
