

ECOSOC Decision 2003/245

Adequate housing as a component of the right to an adequate standard of living

At its 46th plenary meeting, on 23 July 2003, the Economic and Social Council took note of Commission on Human Rights resolution 2003/27 of 22 April 2003¹ and endorsed the Commission's decision to renew the mandate of the Special Rapporteur on adequate housing as a component of the right to an adequate standard of living, and on the right to non-discrimination in this context, for a period of three years and to request the Special Rapporteur to submit a report to the Commission at its sixtieth session.
