At its 10th meeting, on 13 April 2022, in accordance with General Assembly resolution 48/162, the Council elected, by acclamation, CHINA, CUBA, DENMARK, ECUADOR, JAPAN, MOZAMBIQUE, NORWAY, TAJIKISTAN and TURKEY, to the Executive Board of the United Nations Children's Fund for a three-year term beginning on 1 January 2023, to fill vacancies occurring on the expiration of the terms of office of CHINA, CUBA, DENMARK, ESTONIA, ITALY, NORWAY, PARAGUAY, RUSSIAN FEDERATION, UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND, YEMEN and ZIMBABWE.

The Council also elected, by secret ballot, BULGARIA and CZECHIA to the Executive Board of the United Nations Children's Fund for a three-year term beginning on 1 January 2023.

The Council elected, by acclamation, AUSTRIA, for the remainder of the term of office of BELGIUM, beginning on 1 January 2023 and expiring on 31 December 2023, and GREECE and LUXEMBOURG for the remainder of the terms of office of FRANCE and MONACO, respectively, beginning on 1 January 2023 and expiring on 31 December 2024. As a result, as of 1 January 2023, the Executive Board of the United Nations Children's Fund is composed of the following 36 Member States:
