Election of members of the Executive Board of the World Food Programme (E/2022/217)

At its 10th meeting, on 13 April 2022, the Council elected, in accordance with General Assembly resolution 65/266, by acclamation, AUSTRALIA, ETHIOPIA, IRAN (ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF), MAURITANIA, PANAMA and SPAIN to the Executive Board for a three-year term beginning on 1 January 2023.
