At its 14th plenary meeting, on 4 April 2025, the Economic and Social Council, in accordance with its resolutions 1147 (XLI) of 4 August 1966 and 2024/2 of 5 June 2024, elected, by acclamation, AUSTRIA, BENIN, BRAZIL, BURUNDI, CHINA, CUBA, ERITREA, FINLAND, MOROCCO, MOZAMBIQUE, NAMIBIA, NETHERLANDS (KINGDOM OF THE), NEW ZEALAND, NORWAY, PERU and UZBEKISTAN as members of the Statistical Commission for a four-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2026. The Council also elected, by secret ballot, ROMANIA and RUSSIAN FEDERATION as members of the Statistical Commission for a four-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2026.

The newly elected members will fill vacancies occurring on the expiration of the terms of office of AUSTRALIA, BURUNDI, CUBA, FINLAND, NETHERLANDS (KINGDOM OF THE), RUSSIAN FEDERATION, TUNISIA and ZAMBIA.

As a result, as of 1 January 2026, the Statistical Commission is composed of the following 34 Member States: ARGENTINA *, AUSTRIA***, BENIN***, BRAZIL***, BURUNDI***, CHINA***, CUBA***, DOMINICAN REPUBLIC**, ERITREA***, FINLAND *** INDIA*, ITALY**, JAPAN**, MEXICO**, MOROCCO***, MOZAMBIQUE***, NAMIBIA***, NETHERLANDS (KINGDOM OF THE) ***, NEW ZEALAND***, NORWAY***, PERU***, POLAND**, REPUBLIC OF KOREA*, ROMANIA***, RUSSIAN FEDERATION***, SIERRA LEONE*, SLOVENIA*, SWITZERLAND**, UKRAINE*, UNITED ARAB EMIRATES**, UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND**, UNITED REPUBLIC OF TANZANIA*, UNITED STATES OF AMERICA* and UZBEKISTAN***.
